MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIRMAN AND CEO

Dear Friends of Macedonia2025,

We are thrilled to present to you our annual report for 2022. Our organization has made significant strides in fulfilling our mission to shape Macedonia's future by promoting sustainable economic growth that will improve opportunities for citizens, companies, and foreign investors.

None of this would have been possible without the dedication and support of our Board of Directors, membership bodies, staff, volunteers, and donors. We are extremely grateful for your contributions. We are proud of the impact that our organization has made in the community and look forward to continuing this work in the future.

This annual report is a testament to the work that we have done in 2022, the impact we have made, and the people and organizations that supported our mission. Despite the challenging economic and geopolitical environment in 2022, we managed to fully implement the planned programs and activities. In particular, we **implemented 40 programs worth over \$ 450,000** (including in-kind contributions). We served more than **1800 people**, from underprivileged kids to executives from top Macedonian companies. **1,500 young individuals** (the majority of them women) participated in our programs for high-tech skills, coding, and robotics. They were awarded scholarships, no-cost training, and were able to interact with advanced-level STEM business professionals. Over **100 businesses** were involved in our programs, such as business skills training (mini-MBA), training and support for growth delivered by Canadian experts, matching with diaspora professionals for business growth, and training for company executives. We successfully organized the 11th annual Macedonia2025 Summit, a regional conference that serves as a platform for sharing knowledge, connecting organizations, and inspiring change in Southeast Europe, where we hosted **44 speakers and 600 participants**, and engaged high-level policymakers in discussions on best business practices, innovation, and digitalization.

In addition, we were active in **advocacy for a better business environment and boosting the digitalization of our society**. We were involved in high-level policy dialogues on planned tax reforms, measures to overcome the energy crisis, preparation of the new labor code, education policy and reforms, etc. We were active regionally, through participation at conferences and policy dialogues, and partnered with other leading organizations from Europe to exchange knowledge and best practices to ensure positive and sustainable change. We made progress within the Digital Initiative (MK25) where we brought together relevant stakeholders (business and business associations, academia, NGOs, and government representatives) to join forces for faster digitalization of our country.

We continued to serve our role as a convener of different groups, organizations, and individuals, all with the same mission to make Macedonia a better place to work and live. We held events with the Macedonian diaspora in the US, with an aim to connect and improve the networking among our professionals around the world. We offer the best pathway to anyone abroad or in Macedonia who wants to help and support the progress of the country and individuals.

In the coming year, we have set ambitious goals that with the support of our community, we can achieve as we continue our mission to make a lasting difference in the lives of those we serve.

Thank you for your continued support and belief in our mission. We look forward to working with you to create a better future for all.

MAIN STRATEGIC PILLARS

Macedonia2025 accomplishes its mission by implementing programs and activities based on 4 strategic pillars.

Each year, we design and develop our programs in consultation with the business community in Macedonia, our expatriates around the globe, international economic and diplomatic institutions, while at the same time keeping in mind our own research, insights and observations.

In this annual report, we present our main strategic pillars, as well as the major programs and activities that we implemented within each of them in 2022.

Many thanks to all our membership bodies, supporters and friends - what we do would not be possible without your the support, devotion and passion that many of you provided to Macedonia2025 in 2022. Together, we achieved quite an impact towards our strong mission.

PILLAR 1:


ACCELERATING THE GROWTH AND COMPETITIVENESS OF MACEDONIAN BUSINESSES

We are dedicated to supporting the competitiveness of Macedonian companies, stimulating export development and attracting foreign investment. We work on supporting the steady development of entrepreneurs, start-up companies and growth in foreign markets.

The 11th edition of the **Macedonia2025 Summit** was successfully executed on 18-19 May 2022. Summit speakers and participants exchanged knowledge and best practices, inspired reforms and connected over panel sessions and networking events organized around the Summit.

The Summit hosted 44 speakers and 600 participants (430 in-person and 170 online), and engaged high-level policymakers, businesses, members of the academia, civil society and the international community, as well as young talents, to discuss the long-term economic growth, business development and the importance of regional cooperation. The Summit focus was placed on innovation and digitalization as priorities for our country and the region, inspiring economic reforms, and showcased the success of tech companies.

The aim of the Summit is to serve as a platform for sharing knowledge, connecting organizations, and inspiring change in Southeast Europe.



Macedonia2025 enabled high-potential individuals to develop local, regional or international business solutions that create opportunities for their communities through our “**Business and Entrepreneurship Development Training: The Leader Project**”. So far, 384 young business leaders and professionals from Macedonia enhanced their business skills through this program.

33 participants took part in the 2022 Leader Project, undertaking a mini-MBA training delivered by MBA students from the Ivey Business School - one of the top business schools in Canada. The extensive mentorship provided by Macedonian and Canadian professionals for the development and improvement of business plans improved the skills and business competences of participants, with over 85% satisfaction rate. The participants had the opportunity to meet in-person and get business advice from one of the top Macedonian businessmen from the USA, Mike Zafirovski. The top 4 business ideas were awarded with a CESO SACO consultancy.

Macedonia2025 supported 4 Macedonian MSMEs through the **Bitove Family Entrepreneurship Program** in partnership with CESO SACO, thus boosting the growth and internationalization of Macedonian MSMEs with the expertise and knowledge of Canadian experts. The satisfaction survey conducted with each company after the conclusion of the program indicated that satisfaction was very high.

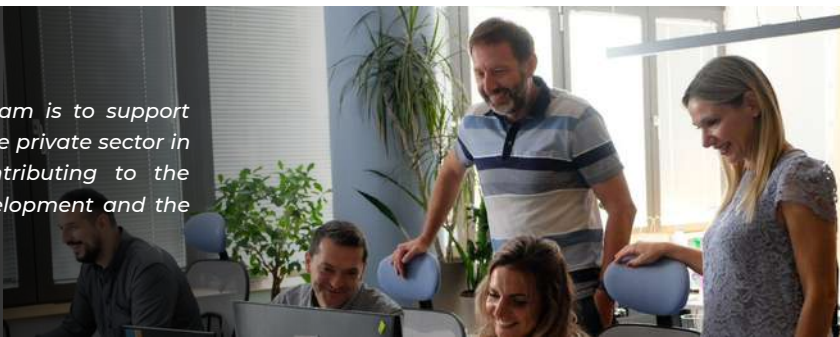
The current contract with CESO SACO was extended until March 31, 2023, and 1 more assignment will commence at the beginning of 2023.

Through the online platform **Connect2MK**, Macedonia2025 connected Macedonian businesses with experts from around the world, therefore helping them grow and prosper in an international environment.

Macedonia2025 established a platform for connecting Macedonian businesses with our professional diaspora using the digital tool Connect2MK. Thus far, 52 companies and 35 experts are engaged on the platform, and in 2022, 2 high-level consultative processes were completed, with 10 ongoing partnership consultations.

ACCELERATING LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT AND SUPPORTING YOUNG TALENTS

We evolve the leadership, managerial and entrepreneurial capacities of top Macedonian leaders of tomorrow, supporting promising young talents to reach their full potential and become successful professionals.

Macedonia2025 elevated the professional and personal development of top Macedonian business leaders through the **Zafirovski Executive Education Program**. We are proud to have engaged the Kellogg alumni (28 Zafirovski fellows) in a variety of Macedonia2025 activities in 2022.

In 2022, 7 senior executives successfully completed the Kellogg Executive Development Program (EDP). We were delighted to learn that 2 of our scholars had been ranked as the top 3 case study winners, among 42 EDP class cohorts!

Furthermore, 7 candidates were recruited for upcoming sessions in 2023.

The aim of the program is to enhance the competencies and performance of Macedonian business leaders and contribute to the further development of the Macedonian economy and workforce.

YOUTH SCHOLARSHIPS

Macedonia2025 awarded scholarships to students from disadvantaged socio-economic backgrounds, helping them reach their full potential and become successful professionals.

In 2022, we administered 132 scholarships to students enrolled in the first year of studies at “Ss. Cyril and Methodius University” in Skopje in the amount of 120,000 MKD per student per year through the Program **“Atanas Bliznakoff” Scholarships for Student Excellence**. The “Giving North Macedonia 2021: Report on the State of Philanthropy”, listed the Macedonia2025 ABF Scholarship Program as one of the Champions of Philanthropy – Charitable Actions that marked the year behind us.

Furthermore, Macedonia2025 awarded 10 scholarships through the **Support Fund for Talented Students “Talents Today – Leaders Tomorrow”**.

These scholarships provide the selected 10 students with the opportunity for continuous talent and skills development through additional training and participation in international competitions. Additionally, Macedonia2025 offers a possibility for mentoring and internships in prominent companies to the program participants. The scholarships are provided with the support of our 2 membership bodies – Ambassadors Club and Advisory Board, as well as through donations and cooperation with corporate and individual partners. Finally, Macedonia2025 organized a business ideas competition and provided financial awards for the winners of the competition titled **“Best Business Concept 2022,”** courtesy of our Board member, Chris Pavlovski, a world-renowned entrepreneur of Macedonian origin.

The aim of these programs is to financially support and mentor talented Macedonian youths from disadvantaged socioeconomic backgrounds, and to give them an opportunity to develop their skills and grow into the leaders of tomorrow.





In 2022, Macedonia2025 developed the coding and robotics skills of over 280 Macedonian youths, both from the country and the diaspora, by organizing and/or awarding scholarships for several tailor-made trainings and camps.

Macedonia2025 organized its second annual **Ohrid High-Tech Excellence Camp**, held under the auspices of President Pendarovski, and awarded 18 scholarships to young learners to participate in the week-long adventure of learning coding and robotics, establishing networks with Macedonian youths from the diaspora, and strengthening and building on native Macedonian culture.

The aim of the program is to develop the coding and robotics skills of Macedonian youths coming from disadvantaged backgrounds, and giving them an opportunity to create networks with Macedonian youths from the diaspora, who in turn, develop deep ties with their homeland.







Macedonia2025 supported and motivated elementary and high school girls to enter STEM fields through our programs “STEM it like a girl” and “STEM Equality”.

The program aims to reduce the gap in the education of young women and men, reduce the professional segregation of women in low-paid occupations and professions with low opportunities for advancement, and reduce the stereotypical division of “male” and “female” occupations. This will reduce gender differences in the labor market (activity, employment, and wages) and women will have a greater role in economic development and greater economic independence.

310 young girls were involved in the 10 motivational speeches and lectures held in primary schools throughout Macedonia.

“ Often, I see girls who do not think they are smart enough or just they aren't good at Math or science - it's all in your head! Self-confidence and knowledge! Other times, girls think they must be isolated or just sit in front of computer. If they follow a STEM field - this is just not true! There are so many options out there, so many career paths that offer more flexibility and opportunities than the traditional ones, but girls often are unaware of those less-travelled career paths in STEM. Start exploring and be open to think differently, you just need to get out of the box of female stereotypes. ”



Furthermore, Macedonia2025 provided scholarships to 12 young learners to participate in the week-long **IWC Summer Camp for Web design in Mavrovo**.

Macedonia2025 organized **2 workshops for robotics and coding** with primary school kids from the Struga region, where 29 young learners had the opportunity to work with lego sets to practice coding and robotics. Many thanks to our Ambassadors Club member, Aleksandra Miloseska for her support in organizing this training!



Macedonia2025 organized a **follow-up advanced training** for 18 Ohrid High-Tech Excellence Camp participants from 2021/22 in Skopje, where the patron of the Camp, President Pendarovski, as well as 2 Macedonia2025 Board Members, had the opportunity to meet (again!) our stellar youth!

Macedonia2025 partnered with Semos Education and Certiadria to provide 200 full scholarships for 2 certified **Microsoft training sessions**.

Finally, Macedonia2025, in cooperation with SEMOS education, organized a one-day training on basic concepts of artificial intelligence, where over 20 young people from our country had the opportunity to learn more about the basics, applicability, and impact of artificial intelligence in various fields of science, business, and everyday life.

PRESIDENTIAL CENTER FOR POLITICAL EDUCATION

Macedonia2025 successfully intensified domestic and international cooperation with leading institutions.

Led by the motto that our impact can be increased only through strong partnerships, we expanded the formal cooperation agreements with 7 domestic and international NGOs, academic institutions and business organizations.

Furthermore, Macedonia2025 implemented projects with highly-esteemed think-tanks from the region, making positive changes to the society and economy, especially the lives of youths.

Finally, we supported youth leadership, knowledge and engagement by actively participating in the Presidential Center for Political Education.



CONFERENCES

Macedonia2025 actively participated and contributed to international, regional and domestic public debates and conferences.

Our CEO, staff, and Board Members took part in 15 conferences, on topics of interest of the organization and for the country, including emigration, diaspora engagement, educational reforms, digitalization, etc. Moreover, Macedonia2025 contributed to 3 high-level policy conferences for the Western Balkan Region.

We advocate for a transparent and corruption-free society by providing expert guidance and research on key economic challenges. From here, we improve the business environment and utilize the support from our expatriates for economic progress of the country.

IN THE MEDIA

Macedonia2025 advocated and inspired reforms that improve the business environment and support companies' growth.

Our CEO and Board members had 10 interviews in written media, 8 TV interviews and debates, 1,200+ media mentions, all related to the economic and democratic prosperity of Macedonia.

What's more, Macedonia2025 representatives engaged in high-level policy discussions related to major economic and business reforms in Macedonia, from tax reforms, post-Covid economic recovery, long-term growth strategy, to energy shock mitigation measures.



PLATFORM FOR PROSPEROUS FUTURE

We continued our work on the Macedonia2025 Platform for Prosperous Future, leading to positive societal impact.

Macedonia2025 held meetings and coordination with key policymakers and stakeholders to foster alignment on the key priorities for long-term growth i.e. prosperous future of Macedonia. We established a task force, Digital Initiative MK2025, focusing on improving the digital transformation in the country, and partnered with academia, like-minded NGOs, government institutions and business associations, all with the aim to make Macedonia more prosperous. Additionally, we organized a panel discussion titled “Digital Transformation: Young People as Drivers of Progress” for over 50 participants.
