2024 Macedonia2025 Summit: Connecting Leaders, Driving Prosperity

The 13th Macedonia2025 Summit, held on 15-17 May 2024, concluded with remarkable success. The event facilitated a vibrant exchange of insights and best practices among speakers and attendees, fostering discussions on reforms and facilitating connections through various panel sessions and networking events.

With 50 distinguished speakers and 700 participants, the Summit brought together eminent figures from the realms of policy-making, business, academia, civil society, the international sphere, and promising young talents. The discussions were centered on critical themes such as long-term economic growth, business enhancement, and the significance of regional collaboration. A special emphasis was placed on innovation and digitalization, positioning them as pivotal for the country and the broader region. The event also highlighted the accomplishments of technology companies, contributing to a narrative of economic innovation.

Beyond the main agenda, 13 side events with speakers and Board members provided additional opportunities for engagement. High-level meetings with the Prime Minister-designate, the President of Macedonia, and the Chamber of Commerce highlighted the Summit's influence on policy making. The event culminated in a Sponsors Lunch attended by 25 sponsors, where the Sponsors Report was unveiled.

The Summit's overarching goal is to act as a platform for the dissemination of knowledge, fostering connections among various organizations, and catalyzing transformative initiatives across Southeast Europe.

Macedonia2025's "Business and Entrepreneurship Development Training: The Leader Project" has empowered individuals with high potential to devise business solutions at local, regional, or international levels. To date, the program has sharpened the business acumen of 408 young business leaders and professionals in Macedonia.

In 2024, 20 participants engaged in the Leader Project, receiving mini-MBA training from MBA candidates at the Ivey Business School, recognized as one of Canada's premier business institutions. This training was aimed at refining and enhancing business plans, leading to a satisfaction rate surpassing 85%. The three most innovative business proposals were honored with consultancy/mentorship services by experts from the Macedonia2025 network.

This Program is designed to instruct Macedonian young professionals, managers, entrepreneurs, and those aspiring to entrepreneurship, in transforming their business ideas into viable projects, and to guide them in scaling their businesses domestically and internationally.

COUNTRY DASHBOARD: TRACKING PROGRESS, INSPIRING ACTION



The Country Dashboard, developed by Macedonia2025, is a key tool for measuring progress against specific, quantifiable goals such as economic development, job creation, competitiveness, legal integrity, and anti-corruption. By regularly updating the Dashboard and producing periodic reports based on its analyses, Macedonia2025 strives to raise public awareness and advocate for accelerated national development.

This year, the Country Dashboard was updated to reflect Macedonia's progress over the past three years and will soon be available on our website. In 2024, insights from the Dashboard were cited in eight media interviews, emphasizing its significance in shaping public dialogue and policy discussions.

The Dashboard not only tracks progress but also provides actionable recommendations and shares global best practices to guide policymakers and key stakeholders. Its ultimate goal is to foster accountability and inspire effective actions that promote a more prosperous and democratic Macedonia.

GoDigital: Pioneering Digital Transformation for Macedonian Businesses

As part of our commitment to advancing digitalization in Macedonia—across government, businesses, and citizens' digital skills—Macedonia2025 established the Centre for Digital Transformation "GoDigital" in 2023. GoDigital is a non-profit organization dedicated to supporting the digitization of micro, small, and medium-sized enterprises (MSMEs) in Macedonia.

Recognizing the need for a robust digital transformation ecosystem, GoDigital focuses on several key elements: training and certifying consultants in digital transformation, selecting companies ready to digitize and enhance their competitiveness, matching these companies with certified consultants, and providing co-financed vouchers to implement digital solutions.

In 2024, 17 consultants were certified, and 15 companies were chosen to join the program. Currently, these consultants are implementing tailored digital solutions at 9 Macedonian MSMEs, driving transformation to improve productivity, efficiency, and competitiveness.

Through strategic leadership, impactful partnerships, and capacity-building initiatives, GoDigital has established itself as a pivotal force in advancing Macedonia's digital transformation and Industry 4.0 integration. We are confident that the Centre for Digital Transformation will significantly enhance the digital maturity of MSMEs, empowering them to thrive in an increasingly competitive global economy.

BUILDING A STRONGER TOMORROW: SCHOLARSHIPS FOR MACEDONIA'S NEXT GENERATION

Macedonia2025 is dedicated to uplifting students from underprivileged socio-economic backgrounds by awarding them scholarships, thus enabling these young individuals to unlock their potential and thrive professionally.

In 2024, the **Atanas Bliznakoff Scholarships for Student Excellence** proudly welcomed 40 outstanding new scholars, selected from a highly competitive open call of 226 applicants. This brings the total to 139 active scholarship recipients at the renowned "Ss. Cyril and Methodius University" in Skopje, each receiving an annual stipend of \$2,500 to support their academic and professional growth. Beyond financial support, the program fosters a sense of community and collaboration through its newly introduced Mentor-Mentee Program and two impactful networking events, which saw 70% of scholars actively participating. The program also celebrated remarkable accomplishments, awarding Certificates of Excellence to 13 scholars for maintaining exceptional 9,5 GPAs and honoring 16 graduates with Certificates for Academic Achievement.





Macedonia 2025 proudly awarded 10 scholarships through the Support Fund for Talented Students, "Talents Today - Leaders Tomorrow." This initiative supports promising students by offering mentorship and coaching from experienced professionals, complemented by opportunities for additional training, internships, and participation in international competitions. The scholarships are generously funded by contributions from our Ambassadors Club and Advisory Board members, alongside donations and partnerships from corporate and individual sponsors. We express our heartfelt gratitude to all who have supported the growth and development of Macedonia's rising talents. To date, we are proud to have supported 50 scholars through this transformative program.



These initiatives are designed to provide financial support, mentorship, and development opportunities to talented Macedonian youth from disadvantaged backgrounds, equipping them to become the leaders of tomorrow. Our end-of-year open call for mentors generated significant interest, attracting over 130 professionals who are eager to make a meaningful impact on the lives of these promising young individuals.

A Week of Innovation and Identity: The 4th Ohrid High-Tech Camp

In July, Macedonia2025 hosted the fourth annual Ohrid High-Tech Excellence Camp, endorsed by President Gordana Siljanovska Davkova, awarding 21 scholarships for an impactful week of learning in coding, programming, and robotics. This initiative aimed to equip Macedonian youth from disadvantaged backgrounds with essential high-tech skills while fostering connections with their diaspora peers, and strengthening their ties to Macedonian culture and heritage.

The camp successfully enhanced participants' digital proficiency, inspiring interest in STEM careers, and promoting sustainability awareness. Additionally, it deepened the bond between Macedonian youth and the diaspora, reinforcing cultural identity and fostering a sense of shared responsibility.

This transformative program empowered young individuals with critical technical skills and a renewed connection to their heritage, marking a key milestone in Macedonia2025's 2024 initiatives.

INNOVATE, CREATE, INSPIRE: HIGHLIGHTS FROM THREE STEAM SUMMER CAMPS

In 2024, Macedonia 2025 continued its mission to inspire the next generation through the STEAM Summer Camp, offering a unique 5-day learning experience for children aged 9-11. This initiative focused on hands-on, interactive education in STEAM, delivered through engaging activities, creative projects, and practical experiments. Designed to support children from socially vulnerable families and lower-income households, the program aimed to spark curiosity and passion for STEAM fields.

This year, between June and August, we created corporate partnerships with Vincini, Vinica (food industry), Comfy Angel, Prilep (textile industry), and SOS Detsko Selo, extending this opportunity to children of employees in labor-intensive roles and children without parental care. Together, we brought this transformative experience to 73 scholars from Kočani, Vinica, Makedonska Kamenica, nearby villages such as Orizari, Bunarci, Trstija, Prilep, and Skopje.

This diverse group of young participants brought a wealth of perspectives, ideas, and cultural richness, making the camp a truly vibrant community. Through the STEAM Summer Camp, Macedonia2025 not only nurtures technical skills but also fosters creativity, teamwork, and a passion for lifelong learning, contributing to the brighter futures of these young minds.

CONNECTING EDUCATION AND IMPACT: THE STORY OF "SCIENCE AND ME" JM Johnson Matthey

The "Science and Me" project, a flagship initiative of the Johnson Matthey Community Impact Program in partnership with Macedonia2025, continues to transform science education in North Macedonia, Launched in 2023, the project aims to empower teachers with modern teaching techniques and inspire students to explore science through hands-on learning experiences.

Key Achievements (2023/2024):

- 21 sixth-grade science teachers from 20 primary schools trained with innovative teaching methodologies such as inquiry-based learning and project-based education, directly impacting 1,100 students.
- Each teacher received a Science Set with educational resources, lab equipment, and materials to facilitate hands-on experiments in their classrooms
- 5 science fairs (4 regional in Veles, Skopje, Delcevo and Struga + 1 in Skopje (kick-off))
 engaged: 186 sixth-grade students proudly presenting their innovative science
 projects to 1,300+ peers as audience members.
- A study visit to the Johnson Matthey plant in Skopje gave 20 students and 5 teachers firsthand exposure to scientific applications in industry, further bridging the gap between education and real-world STEM careers.
- 36 Johnson Matthey volunteers contributed 300+ days to mentoring, organizing fairs, and delivering inspirational sessions.
- A "Science for the Future" promotional campaign gathered 18 inspirational stories, boosting outreach through newsletters and social media.

Beyond the direct classroom impact, the project also conducted a smailto:study, measuring improvements in teachers' confidence and motivation post-intervention. Findings emphasized the need for continued teacher support, better access to educational resources, and investment in experiential learning.

Encouraged by its success, the Science and Me initiative will expand in the 2024/2025 school year, aiming to train over 100 science teachers, increase the number of participating schools, and impact more than 2,500 students through expanded science fairs and professional development opportunities.





FOSTERING GREEN INNOVATION AND YOUTH LEADERSHIP: EMPOWERING SUSTAINABLE SOLUTIONS FOR A BETTER FUTURE

Demonstrating our dedication to fostering innovation and leadership, Macedonia2025 proudly partnered with the National Centre for Development of Innovation and Entrepreneurial Learning (NCDIEL) in organizing a dynamic business competition "Best Business Concept in Green Innovation" for high school students. The event brought together 16 teams and over 200 students, who showcased their creativity and entrepreneurial spirit in the National Secondary Schools Competition's Green Innovation Final Pitch. We are delighted to celebrate the success of the four winning teams, whose innovative ideas stood out, exemplifying the potential of Macedonia's young talents to drive sustainable and forward-thinking solutions.





As part of our commitment to fostering sustainability and innovation, Macedonia2025 proudly supported ARNO's 10th Annual "Green Ideas" Competition, a platform that promotes environmentally sustainable entrepreneurial solutions. In addition to establishing the GoDigital Center for Digital Transformation, in 2024 Macedonia2025 developed the Vision for Accelerated Growth—a strategic document outlining actionable measures aimed at inspiring decisive action from all stakeholders and ensuring effective implementation.

Ahead of the 2024 parliamentary elections, the **Vision for Accelerated Growth** was presented to all major political parties and the media. We are proud to report that the government's official work plan incorporated 91% of the measures proposed in this document, marking a significant step toward achieving Macedonia's long-term economic goals. Macedonia2025 has been actively working with the government to support the achievement of the priorities set in the Vision for Accelerated Growth. This strong alignment demonstrates the government's commitment to implementing transformative policies that advance Macedonia's economic development.

VISION FOR ACCELERATED GROWTH: A STRATEGIC PATHWAY FOR MACEDONIA'S PROSPERITY

Macedonia2025 reinforced its dedication to Macedonia's economic progress through the Vision for Accelerated Growth, a comprehensive reform plan aimed at improving the quality of life by accelerating sustainable economic development. Building on the foundation of the Platform for Prosperous Future introduced in 2020, the plan is anchored in three fundamental principles:

- Zero tolerance for corruption through transparency, merit-based systems, and accountability.
- Consistent GDP growth above 5% driven by investments in education, business reforms, export promotion, and reducing the gray economy.
- Efficient public administration and accession to the European Union.

Acknowledging the complex development challenges Macedonia faces, the plan emphasizes the urgency for decisive action to close the gap between current living standards and those of EU member states. It presents a clear roadmap of concrete measures designed to inspire all stakeholders to work collaboratively toward national progress.

The Vision for Accelerated Growth focuses on three strategic areas critical to fostering long-term economic development:

1. Comprehensive Digitalization:

The plan promotes the complete digitalization of government services, enabling both citizens and businesses to access essential services electronically. It also supports the digital transformation of micro, small, and medium-sized enterprises (MSMEs) through initiatives such as the GoDigital Center for Digital Transformation. This approach aims to enhance efficiency, reduce corruption, and boost overall economic growth.

2. Strengthening Business Competitiveness:

Recognizing that the country's economic growth is closely linked to its export capacity, the plan calls for reducing bureaucratic obstacles that hinder exporters and limit competitiveness. Simplifying regulations will help businesses operate more efficiently and tap into new markets.

To attract foreign direct investments (FDIs), the plan proposes the development of a modern, investor-friendly strategy and the establishment of streamlined processes that make investing in Macedonia more accessible and appealing.

3. Leveraging the Diaspora's Potential:

With ongoing emigration and population decline leading to labor shortages, the plan emphasizes the importance of engaging the Macedonian diaspora. It outlines policies designed to facilitate and ease the return of expatriates and create opportunities for them to invest in and contribute to the local economy.

The Vision for Accelerated Growth is the result of extensive research, expert insights, and a shared commitment to Macedonia's long-term prosperity. Macedonia2025 stands ready to collaborate with all relevant stakeholders—including government bodies, the business community, academia, and civil society—to drive the implementation of these reforms. The organization is also prepared to leverage its global network and resources to support efforts that align with this vision.

In 2024, Macedonia2025 presented the plan to key stakeholders, advocating for its integration into the country's broader development strategy. The Vision for Accelerated Growth serves as a unified call to action, inviting all sectors of society to work together toward building a stronger, more prosperous future for the nation. We proudly state that the organization and its members work closely with the government and several government institutions on implementation of key reforms and measures which are part of the Vision, as well as of the Government Work Plan 2024-2028.

PERHOUSE PROJECT: ADVANCING LABOR CONDITIONS IN THE PHS SECTOR

In 2024, Macedonia2025 successfully concluded the 2-year long PERHOUSE Project, focusing on the working conditions and industrial relations in the Personal and Household Services (PHS) sector. This year's activities included a workshop in Macedonia with key stakeholders from the PHS sector and the delivery of three major outputs: the National Report, Policy Brief, and Leaflet.

On June 21st, the project's final conference brought together 50 participants to discuss findings and insights. A short documentary was also produced, highlighting national findings and promoting awareness of key issues in the PHS sector. The project deliverables—Country Report, Policy Brief, Video, and Leaflet—were disseminated widely to ensure their impact and reach.

In the final phase of the project, which officially ended on July 31st, a comparative report summarizing findings across all partner countries was published. The PERHOUSE Project stands as a testament to Macedonia2025's commitment to advancing knowledge and improving labor conditions in key sectors.









BARSERVICE: STRENGTHENING COLLECTIVE BARGAINING IN THE SERVICE SECTOR

In 2024, Macedonia2025 continued its leadership in the BARSERVICE project, an EUfunded initiative to strengthen collective bargaining in the service sector across nine countries. This year marked significant progress, with the completion of key research activities and collaborative meetings with project partners.

The year began with an in-person meeting to officially launch the project and the initiation of field research. Interviews were conducted across three sectors to gather insights into industrial relations, collective bargaining practices, and sector-specific challenges. A second partner meeting provided an apportunity to share initial findings and align on next steps. Throughout the year, interviews with key stakeholders were finalized, and the process of reporting on the first half of the project commenced. Looking ahead, the project is poised to deliver impactful insights and recommendations to advance industrial relations in the service sector.
