Bringing Our Board and Community Together in Miami

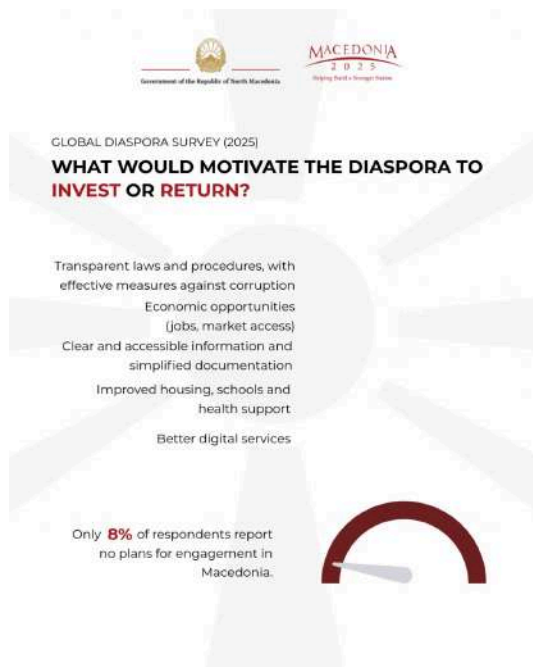

These insights are already being translated into action. Over the past year, Macedonia2025 has supported concrete policy recommendations and implementation in close collaboration with government institutions.

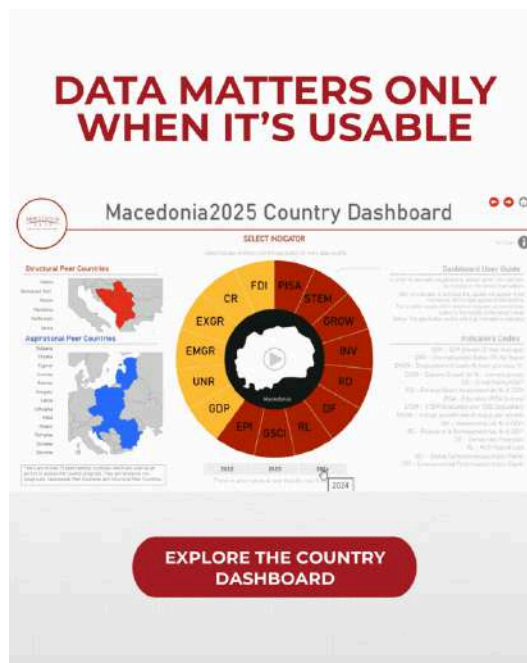
This work includes:
